The Leader in Me focus for November is Habit 3 - Put First Things First. This habit emphasizes the importance of prioritizing tasks and managing time effectively. Habit 3 encourages children to focus on what is most important rather than getting distracted by less meaningful activities or tasks. Children develop a sense of responsibility and self discipline.

At home, caregivers can support this habit by setting specific goals for school projects or personal commitments. Discuss the importance of completing high priority tasks first and model this behavior in your own daily routines. By helping your child understand the value of effective time management, you empower them to take charge of their responsibilities and make thoughtful choices, ultimately preparing them for future success.
