

SCHEDULE CHANGE

At their meeting on April 12, the Southeast Polk School Board discussed options and voted to make up instructional hours by changing the last Wednesday in April and the first two Wednesdays in May into full student instructional days.

The Wednesdays that will change to regular full days are: Wednesday, April 30, 2025 Wednesday, May 7, 2025 Wednesday, May 14, 2025

Wednesday, May 28, 2025, which was already scheduled for a full day, will be the final day of the school year for K-5 students. The kindergarten concert and graduation will be at 12pm. The fifth grade concert and celebration will be at 1:45pm.

On the four Wednesday dates listed above, Four Mile dismissal times will be at 3:40 for family pick-up and 3:45 for bus riders.

Please note that Wednesday, May 21 will have early dismissal. Students will be dismissed at 1:40 for family pick-up and 1:45 for buses.

MAY OLYMPICS

The Four Mile Olympics will be on Monday, May 19. Based on feedback, we are making some changes. They are briefly outlined below:

- Grades 3-5 will go to the Junior High Track. We will leave at 9:05 and we will return by 11:30. Students and staff will sit on the WEST sidelines. We are asking all families to sit in the WEST bleachers.
- Grades K-2 will have the Olympics here at Four Mile in the afternoon. We'll start at 1pm and will wrap up at 3pm(ish). Families are invited to watch. They should bring lawnchairs.
- Olympics will have a "track and field" feel.
- We are excited for this annual event!

As we look back on the school year, it's amazing to see how much our Four Mile students have grown. Not just in what they've learned, but in how they've become more responsible, confident, and kind. They've worked hard through challenges, celebrated successes, and continued to build important life skills.
