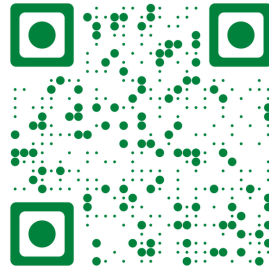


# YOU'RE INVITED!
